Goals 2007-2008

Kinnelon High School

Objective: By June 2008, as a result of year long focus on Differential Instruction, and in response to a concentrated test data analysis and skill analysis by the mathematics staff, **45%** of 11th grade students will perform in the Advanced Proficient range.

Objective: By June 2008 as a result of a two year initiative that includes curriculum alignment, teacher training, and review of student requirements for registration in courses, 75% of the students enrolled in Advanced Placement Courses will achieve a grade of 3 or more on the Advanced Placement Examinations.

Pearl R. Miller School

Objective: By June 2008, as a result of curriculum enhancements and professional development programs, the advanced proficient scores for seventh grade students in the area of mathematics will increase from 29.3% on the 2007 NJASK 6 test to 40% on the 2008 NJASK 7 test.

Objective: By June 2008, as a result of curriculum enhancements and professional development programs, the advanced proficient scores for seventh grade students in the area of language arts will increase from 32.6% on the 2007 NJASK 6 test to 37% on the 2008 NJASK 7 test.

Stonybrook School

Objective: By June 2008, there will be an increase in advanced proficient scores on the Language Arts Literacy section of the NJ-ASK4 from 6.9% to 12% on the NJ-ASK5. This increase will be realized through cluster analysis of the Language Arts Literacy section results.

Objective: By June 2008, there will be an increase of 5% (from 6.9 on NJ ASK 4 to 7.4 on NJ ASK 5) on the Geometry and Measurement cluster of the Mathematics section. This increase will be realized through cluster analysis of the mean score on the 2007 NJ-ASK 4 Mathematics section results.

Kiel/Sisco

Objective: By June 2008, due to increased writing workshop strategies and continued professional development, our second grade students will increase their average writing score in "organization" by 10% from fall to spring as measured by the Kinnelon Grade 2 Writing Rubric.

Objective: By June 2008, due to curricular immersion of Character Education traits, students will exhibit respect for self, others, and property as measured by a 15% increase in the submission of positive Kiel/Sisco Code of Conduct Respect Forms.
