

AP BIOLOGY SUMMER ASSIGNMENT

READ chapters: 26 and 6, 23 and 25, 29 and 30

The first class period will be a review of chapters: 26 and 6.

The second class will be an exam on these chapters.

The third class will review chapters: 23 and 25.

The fourth class will be an exam on chapters: 23 and 25.

The fifth class will review chapters 29 and 30.

The sixth class will be an exam on chapters 29 and 30

This schedule does not include lab day. On that day, we will do a lab.

FOR EACH CHAPTER, YOU MUST: Answer all the Evolution Connection, Scientific Inquiry, and Science, Technology and Society Questions at the end of each chapter (See gold highlighted boxes). These must be answered in complete sentences and turned in the first day of class for all chapters.

Turn in all work on time: Late Work will not be accepted and will earn no points. If you are absent, see Ms. Buser as soon as you return.

This is a college level course you must be prepared for all tests and assignments. Keep up with your reading, listen carefully in class, take notes, study for all exams, and come for extra help as needed. In addition to regular office hours, I am available most mornings before school starts in 312. **It is assumed that you have done your reading before you come to class and are prepared to discuss topics, ask, and answer questions.** It is recommended that you use the study disc in the back of your text and do all concept check questions within the chapters and the self quiz at the end of the chapters. If you cannot answer these questions, it means you need to go back over the material (the answers are in the Appendix-use it). If you work hard, you should do well. If you do not prepare carefully you will do poorly.
