2009 Summer Assignment

The following summer projects are due the first week of school.

All assignments should be on an 8.5 x 11" area. Unless specified, any medium may be used. Technical skills, creativity and composition of the page will be critiqued and graded.

- 1** Create 5 different visual interpretations of a STAR (on 5 different sheets of paper)
- 2** Draw or visually interpret an object of nature
- 3** Draw or visually interpret your hand
- 4** Create a self portrait
- 5** Draw or visually interpret fabric folds
- 6** Try to accurately render a section of a room or architectural building that includes an open door in perspective
- 7** Select and draw the same object in 5 different mediums, each on a separate sheet (e.g., charcoal, pen, pencil, watercolor, acrylic paint, collage or pastel)
- 8** Visually interpret one of the following words:
Defense, Satisfaction, Hunger, Endlessness, Majesty or Seclusion
- 9** Complete a sketchbook with a minimum of 20 pages filled with concepts, designs and or drawings
(date every page)
- 10** Visit an *exhibit* at a museum or gallery and be prepared to share your experience with the class (including literature from the exhibit) - Or - Visit an exhibit at a museum online and be prepared to make a presentation to the class (including printed visuals from the site)
- 11** Write a minimum of 10 ideas that you can explore for the Concentration Section of your portfolio
(a concept, theme or concern of personal interest that will become the foundation for an extensive exploration in the creation of a body of progressive work)
- 12** Collect all of your art (your current portfolio) and bring it to class on the second day
