New laws:

As of July 1, 2004 you can no longer talk on a hand-held wireless telephone while driving in New Jersey. However you can use a “Hands-free” wireless telephone to talk while driving. This new laws will be enforced on all public roadways in New Jersey. **Break this law and you can be fined \$250.**
