## **KHS FUTURE BUSINESS LEADERS OF AMERICA**

**"FBLA" NEWS:** The KHS Future Business Leaders of America, better known as KHS FBLA, has hit the ground running! FBLA is a national organization committed to facilitating the transition of its members from their educational development into their professional career paths. Following the FBLA officer elections in October, the Board and its members made an executive decision on their first business venture and chose a very worthwhile cause for their first fundraiser. The FBLA advisors, Anna Ellington and Jeffrey Snyder, oversaw the very profitable business venture, which involved the sale of tasty lollipops at KHS lunches. To begin this fundraiser, the FBLA worked together and created a business and marketing plan in order to ensure financial success. After much brainstorming, the FBLA members researched and selected a lollipop company which offered fantastic prices. The FBLA then calculated profits based on potential sales and cost. The group then devised a strong promotional campaign in order to publicize the fundraiser. To make this happen, the students created posters, flyers and had FBLA officers make an appearance on "The Morning Show" to explain the fundraiser and promote the lollipop sales.

As far as the fundraising choice, one of the FBLA officers had brought the fundraising idea to the Board members and the group decided that it was not only a wise choice, but a choice that would make a difference to a very special person. The FBLA made the decision to raise money for Adrian Simone, a 19 year old lance corporal who joined the Marines after graduating from



Montville Township High School last year. Last July, Simone was deployed to Afghanistan and one month in, his unit walked across an explosive device and Simone lost both of his legs. He is now recuperating at a hospital in Bethesda, Maryland. The KHS FBLA has raised over \$500 for Lance Corporal Adrian Simone and additionally, the KHS student body signed get well and thank you posters for Simone when they purchased the lollipops. Several of the FBLA members also wrote lengthy letters to Simone expressing their sympathy and thanking him for his efforts. The FBLA plans on sending the money and cards to Lance Corporal Adrian Simone to thank him for his service and sacrifice for our country.

The FBLA has worked diligently on this business venture/fundraising idea. The students devoted many hours of hard work to making this event successful. They were very proud to have raised so much money for a worthy cause by implementing and executing their business and marketing plans. The KHS FBLA has future plans for other business ventures, including holiday candy sales, working with the Stonybrook Business Club and March of Dimes fundraising events. Flu Shots Still Available:  
\$15.00 per Flu Shot. Free with Primary Medicare Part B ONLY [No HMO Insurance]  
Our flu clinics have ended, but we still have vaccine available to anyone over the age of 6 months. Please call for an appointment.  
Please note: Flu vaccines are **mandatory** for children attending preschool.

Gardasil HPV: Free through the health department.  
Recommended for children age 9-26.



**Zostavax Vaccine:**  
Now available through the Health Department. Recommended for persons age 60 and older to prevent shingles. Cost: \$200 per vaccination.

## Medical Equipment for Loan

The Health Department has a supply of walkers, canes, wheelchairs, shower chairs, elevated toilet seats available for loan to residents. Contact the Public Health Nurses for more information.



## Walk-in Blood Pressure Checks:

Public health nurses schedule monthly blood pressure clinics throughout our area. This service is free to all residents.
