It's Time for 2010 Kindergarten Registration



Registration will take place this month at Kiel School for the incoming kindergarten students for the 2010/11 school year. The dates and times for registration are as follows:

Tues. Jan 12th 5:00 – 8:00 PM
Wed. Jan 13th 9:30 AM—11:30 AM
1:30 PM— 2:30 PM

Parents **must** bring a copy of the birth certificate, proof of residency (Title, Deed, Lease) and immunization records to register. Bringing your child to registration is not recommended.

Babysitting will not be available. The registration process takes about 45 minutes. If you have a child who will be five on or before October 1, 2010, s/he is eligible for the Kinnelon Kindergarten Program. Please tell your neighbors and friends who have eligible children.
