Pearl R. Miller School is once again pleased to offer "Teen Canteen". These are evenings of fun for all 6<sup>th</sup>, 7<sup>th</sup> & 8<sup>th</sup> graders residing or going to school in Kinnelon. The goal of the canteens is to provide a safe non-competitive environment where students can have fun. Many activities are offered such as dancing to a DJ, basketball, board games, arts and crafts and special entertainment. Students can participate in any or all activities. We recommend that students bring small change to purchase refreshments, which are sold at a nominal charge.

Due to the overwhelming response and the large group of middle school children, it has become necessary to make some changes. This year the 6<sup>th</sup> and 8<sup>th</sup> graders will attend 3 teen canteens. The 7<sup>th</sup> graders will attend 4 teen canteens, as one of their canteens was cancelled last school year. 8<sup>th</sup> Graders: November 2<sup>nd</sup>, February 1<sup>st</sup>, March 14<sup>th</sup>
