Intervention and Referral Services Team
General Information

The Intervention and Referral Services Team is comprised of faculty members at Kiel School who meet weekly to work with classroom teachers to support student growth. When a student is experiencing challenges, the classroom teacher works to help within the classroom by implementing strategies specific to student need. If these challenges remain, we have resources available within our school, created with the specific purpose of indentifying additional supports that may be of assistance.

The I&RS team consists of Kiel faculty members and the building principal. Upon receiving a request for assistance, the team members work collaboratively with one another and the student's parents or guardian. A collaborative action plan will be developed. It is expected that the plan will provide appropriate and specific support(s) so that the student can be successful. The effectiveness of the plan will be assessed, strategic changes recommended if necessary, and progress will be regularly communicated to the I&RS team and parents. The action plan is a written document, a copy of which is mailed to the parent/guardian. If deemed appropriate, the plan is carried over into the next school year.

The team values parent input as an important part of this process and believes our collaborative approach is a positive one that promotes success for all students.
