

Meeting opened @ 7:30 p.m. in the KHS Library.

Administrator's Report presented by Dr. Merckling:

- The Fall Drama, The Election, is being presented on Nov. 14th and 15th.
- The Fashion Show is Wed., Nov. 20th.
- The first Marking Period ended.
- The Fall athletic season is ending and it was a very successful season for all sports.
- The Winter athletic teams are starting their practices.

Clubs and Organization Presentation for Funding Requests

Trust Club is requesting funds to purchase games to be used for their visits to the elementary schools. \$250

The KHS Auditorium Club is requesting funds to be used to upgrade the remainder of the sound equipment in the KHS Auditorium. \$6,346.10

The Hockey Team is requesting funds to pay for 14 practice sessions at \$410/hr for a total of \$5,740.

The Swim Team requested funding for 2 of the 4 pieces of equipment they need to analyze strokes and help develop the team overall. \$299.98.

Secretary's Report from the Oct., 2013 meeting was reviewed by Mary Anne Gorman:

A motion to accept the report was made by Juan C. Faisca, seconded by Alicia de Torres.

Treasurer's Report presented by Treasurer Elaine Hamill:

- There is \$41,975 in the account.
- 50% of the Membership Dues is given to the Fashion Show, about \$5,000. Adding these monies to the profit of the Fashion Show gives an unfair representation as to the profit of this fundraiser. A motion was made by Elaine to vote on whether or not the Dues monies should continue to be distributed to the Fashion Show. It was voted that no monies from Membership Dues should be given to the Fashion Show budget. This was accepted by Lori Cohen and seconded by Marianne DeAlessi.

Membership Dues update presented by Paula Williams and Carol Weidemann:

- \$10,080 has been deposited.
- There are 690 students, 567 families in the school. 343 families paid dues, 224 unpaid families.
- 131 seniors, 110 Juniors, 87 sophomores and 100 freshman paid dues.
- 40 extra Student Directories have been paid for. 11 free Directories will be distributed to eligible families.
- The teachers will distribute the Directories in Block D on Thursday.

Project Graduation Update presented by Bernadine Ferrari on behalf of her, Karen Park and Linda Graupe:

- A Committee meeting date has not yet been determined.
- As always, underclassman parents are needed to chaperone Project Graduation.

Fashion Show update presented by Barbara Burns on behalf of Dina Sweeney:

- The Fashion Show is taking place on Wed., Nov. 20 in the KHS Auditorium.
- Donations are still being accepted and are currently more than expected for this time.

- About 400 ads have been sold for the Program. Everyone proofed the listing of the Chairpeople's names that will be printed in the Program.
- There are about 125 ever-changing models.
- There are 57 baskets, 23 Super Sweeps and 4 Special Sweep prizes. About \$2,000 has been spent on basket items.
- 92 tickets have been sold so far.
