AP Studio Art 2D students are expected to work on a college level in their conceptualizing, exploration of themes, skills, self-management, presentation and creation of art that consistently and continually raises their personal standards.

The summer AP Studio Art assignment is designed to demonstrate your technical skills, research capabilities, creative expression and dedication.

Your summer assignment is due on the first day of class in September.

Assignments 1-10 must be placed in digital folders with the title of the theme (ex: Water, Lines, Shadows, etc).

The 10 completed themed folders must be placed within a **Master digital folder.**

Title the Master folder: LastFirstname-AP-Summer (ex SmithJohn-AP-Summer).

Bring this digital folder on a **Flash or Portable Drive** with you on the first day of class.

You may not e-mail this assignment. Do not bring the summer assignment in on your phone!!!!!!

There will be a class critique of the images the first week(s) of school.

The list below gives you 10 themes. You must photograph 10 **DIFFERENT** photos for each theme (ex: **DIFFERENT** locations, props, angles, models, etc.). The subject (1-10) must be the **hero** of the image!

Beyond the given constraints, let your creativity inspire you without limitations.

1. Circles and spheres
2. Water
3. Lines
4. Shadows
5. Reflections
6. Landscapes
7. Stylized Portraits (Not Face-book shots)
8. Interesting objects
9. Angles in architecture (composed to focus on angles)
10. Select a theme of your choice that is different from the 1-9 given themes.

Ten points will be deducted for each late day. The assignment will not be accepted from your phone or e-mailed. Images not placed within labeled folders will not be accepted.
