

Kinnelon District Goals for 2015 - 2016

DISTRICT GOALS

- 1. Improved student achievement remains a goal for Kinnelon Public Schools. Until such time that PARCC assessment can provide reliable measures of student achievement, we will measure student achievement through the use of district benchmark assessments in Mathematics and English Language Arts for students in each school as identified in the respective school's action plan. In addition, where standardized assessment results are available, those data will also inform our student achievement gains.
- Continued improvements to school climate in all district schools as measured by a climate survey, measures of student discipline referrals, and the reduction in both HIB investigations and confirmed incidents of HIB in each school.
- 3. Meaningfully advance educational technology use in the district as measured by classroom observation data, notation in lesson plans, attendance at educational technology professional development opportunities, through the use of teacher websites, and through the use of technology focused walkthrough data.
- 4. Enhance school-community relations as measured by surveys, participant attendance at parent workshops, and website and social media counters.
