Community & School Profile

Kinnelon Borough, a residential community of approximately 9000 residents, is located within the ruggedly beautiful highland section of Morris County. Kinnelon High School, with an enrollment of approximately 600 students in grades 9-12, offers students an extensive array of advanced placement, honors and college preparatory courses and is classified by the New Jersey Department of Education as an "I" district. It is historically named as one of the highest ranking schools in the state. The Kinnelon High School professional staff of approximately 60 is exceptionally qualified with an average of 15 years experience. More than seventy five percent of the faculty hold at least a master's degree. More than 80% of Kinnelon students actively participate in school life through involvement in co-curricular activities, including 28 athletic sports and over 30 clubs and activities.

Graduation Requirements

In order to graduate and receive a high school diploma from Kinnelon High School, each student must demonstrate proficiencies in required state mandated testing, successfully adhere to district policies governing attendance and successfully complete 140 credits with the following requirements:

English - 20 credits
Science - 18 credits
Mathematics - 15 credits
World Language - 10 credits
United States History - 10 credits
World History/Cultures - 5 credits
21st Century Skills - 5 credits
Arts (Visual, Fine/Performing) - 5 credits
Financial Literacy - 2.5 credits
1 year of Physical Education & Health for each year of enrollment

Curriculum

Kinnelon High School offers an enriched curriculum, which emphasizes a traditional college preparatory program of study. Students must carry a minimum of thirty-five credits each year, seven courses per semester, but are encouraged to take more if they so choose. The school day consists of six instructional class periods each averaging sixty minutes in length. The students' eight classes meet on a rotating four day schedule.

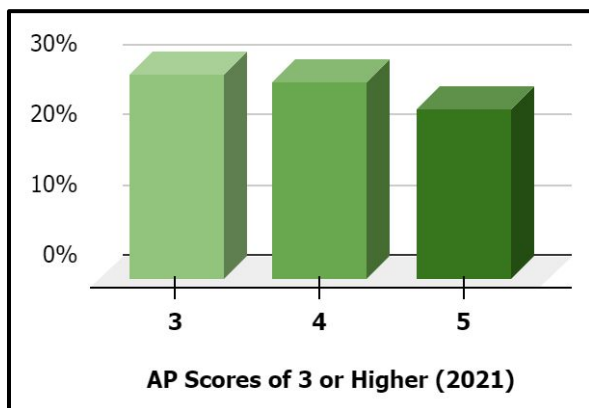

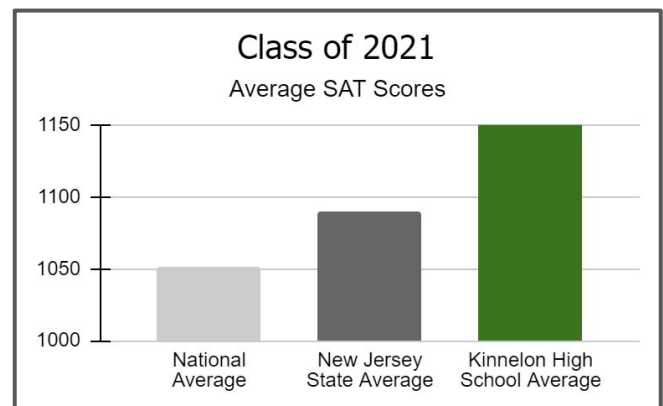
2021 Advanced Placement Scores

Educational Practice During COVID-19

KHS practiced a virtual learning model from March 16-June 17, 2020. Due to the instructional disruptions, students were offered a Pass/Fail option for their courses, as noted by a P or an F in those cases on the transcript. Starting September 10, 2020 students could select full-time remote learning or a hybrid model. Our hybrid model had two groups, each attending school for two full-days per week with virtual instruction on the remaining three days. Wednesdays were virtual learning days school-wide.
