WHEREAS, the Kinnelon Board of Education requested Educational Services Commission of Morris County to solicit bids for transportation services commencing on September 1, 2023 through June 30, 2024; AND

WHEREAS, the School Business Administrator reviewed the lowest bid result received by the Educational Services Commission of Morris County and hereby recommends that the Board approve the proposal from First Student Inc., Butler, NJ in the amount of \$1,057,778.35 as **Finance, Facilities and Security Attachment C**.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, that the Kinnelon Board of Education has considered the recommendation and hereby authorizes the School Business Administrator to approve the above agreement for the 2023-2024 school year.

12. WHEREAS, the Kinnelon Board of Education wishes to deposit anticipated current year surplus into a Capital Reserve and/or Maintenance Reserve/Emergency Reserve account at year-end, and

WHEREAS, the Kinnelon Board of Education has determined that up to \$1,000,000 is available for such purpose of transfer;

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED by the Kinnelon Board of Education that it hereby authorizes the district's School Business Administrator to make this transfer consistent with all applicable laws and regulations.

18. Resolution Increasing the Bid Threshold - Qualified Purchasing Agent

WHEREAS, The Kinnelon Board of Education School Business Administrator/Board Secretary possesses a Qualified Purchasing Agent (QPA) certificate;

WHEREAS, the State Treasurer, in consultation with the Governor and pursuant to N.J.S.A. 52:34-7, and N.J.S.A. 18A:18A-3(b), has increased the bid threshold

amount for school districts with a Qualified Purchasing Agent, from \$40,000 to **\$44,000**, effective July 1, 2023;

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED that the Kinnelon Board of Education pursuant to N.J.S.A. 18A:18A-3 (a) and N.J.A.C. 5:34-5.4, establishes and sets the bid threshold amount of **\$44,000** for the Board of Education, and further authorizes **Kerry A. Keane, SBA/Board Secretary**, the Qualified Purchasing Agent, to award contracts, in full accordance with N.J.S.A. 18A:18A-3 (a), for those purchases that do not exceed the aggregate of the newly established bid threshold amount.

19. **BE IT RESOLVED**, that the Board of Education upon recommendation of the School Business Administrator, Kerry Keane, hereby approve the renewal of the contract with **Maschio's Food Services** for the 2023-2024 school year for the operation of the school food service program.

Be it resolved, that the Kinnelon Board of Education will pay Maschio's Food Services an annual management fee of \$20,009.50, payable in ten monthly installments of \$2,000.95 for the contract period effective July 1, 2023 thru June 30, 2024.
