She has contributed to numerous professional publications including Renaissance Reading’s *What Kids are Reading*, is a frequent lecturer at the Teachers College Reading and Writing Project and has taught in the Writing Institute at Sarah Lawrence College

This Bear's Birthday (NEW RELEASE) (Pre-k- 1)


